Imagine LIFE

Students from Pierce and Van Buren Elementary Schools battle poverty, gang violence and hunger daily and can often find trouble quicker than they can find guidance. The Y stepped in to change that. Dozens of families across the Oklahoma City area have received financial assistance to attend the Y after school programs like those at Pierce & Van Buren where they learn about character development and life skills like conflict resolution and social competency. Students also receive help with homework and participate in regular physical activity through sports and games.



Imagine HOPE

Domestic abuse left Jordan's mom single, depressed and emotionally unavailable to him and his brother. She knew she needed help, so she turned to the Y.

The Y provided a safe and loving environment for the family. With the help of the Y financial assistance program, Jordan and his brother attended summer camp where they made friends and were able to experience childhood again. Their mother combated depression through exercise in a supportive environment, revitalizing her as a parent to reunite the once broken family.

- \$35** Provides a child with 8 consecutive swim lessons – skills instruction and water safety.
- \$65** Provides a child one week in our Before and After School Program filled with arts & crafts, sports & games, homework time, a wholesome snack, fitness programs and more.
- \$85** Allows a child to play baseball, basketball, flag football, volleyball, or soccer for 10 weeks.
- \$125** Allows a senior adult to participate for 12 weeks in the Y Personal Fitness Program that's targeted toward seniors who are inactive, but ready to be fit.

- \$465** Provides an adult with a one year membership to become healthier while developing new friendships and interests.
- \$700** Allows a local family to use the Y and participate in programs for an entire year.
- \$1000** Provides a week long swim instruction course and transportation to the Y for an entire Oklahoma City Public Schools 2nd grade class.
